Aspen

 Aspen will be updated weekly. All grades will be on the Aspen platform. Check your Aspen account weekly for grade updates and missing assignments.

Cell Phone Policy

 Cell phones must be turned off inside of the classroom. Students should not be on their cell phones at any point in time inside of the classroom. Cell phones should not be visible nor on desk during the class period. If students have their phone out, it will be taken for the duration of the class period or given to the office. Violations of this policy will follow the consequences of the Cocke County School Board Cell Phone Policy.

Academic Honesty

- The purpose of this policy is to maintain academic integrity, uphold ethical standards, and ensure fair assessment practices in the classroom regarding the use of technology, including Artificial Intelligence (AI).
- Cheating Definition- Cheating is defined as any act of dishonesty, deception, or fraudulent behavior aimed at gaining an unfair academic advantage. This includes, but is not limited to, the following:
 - Plagiarism: Using someone else's work (words, ideas, or images) without proper acknowledgement.
 - Unauthorized Collaboration: Working together on assignments or exams without explicit permission.
 - Unauthorized Assistance: Receiving help during assignments or exams without teacher approval.
 - Using Unauthorized Aids: Using notes, textbooks, or electronic devices not allowed by the instructor during exams or assignments.
 - Artificial Intelligence (AI): Students are PROHIBITED from using AI or machine learning algorithms to complete assignments, exams, or any other form of academic work.
- Cheating will result in the student receiving a "0" for the assignment and further consequences are outlined in the Cocke County Student Handbook.

Tardy Policy

• Students should be on time to class every day. If a student is late to class 3 times, a write-up will be submitted to the office. After the 3rd tardy, students will be written up every time that they are tardy to class.

Make-Up Work Policy & Missing Assignments

 Each class will have a Remind group. All students should join the Remind group to receive updates and reminders about the class.

Homework

• English I Honors: Students will have homework assignments in this course. Students will have readings and other assignments to complete at home before

the next class setting. Students will be responsible for bringing all reading and homework materials to class each day. Some homework assignments will be graded. Most at-home reading assignments will have quizzes.
