- D.** Approve the attached Cocke County School System High School Tardy Discipline Protocol developed in tandem by both high schools to address the issue of unexcused tardies and leave earlys. **(see attached)**
- E.** Approve the Cocke County School System to partner with Action for Healthy Kids' (AFHK) in applying for the Tennessee Department of Health's "Creating Healthier Rural Communities through the End Zone for Chronic Disease Prevention Model. If awarded, this partnership would provide approximately \$75,000 - \$150,000 per year over five years to support strategies that improve access to healthy food, physical activity, and social connection.

Approve the Cocke County School System to partner with Action for Healthy Kids' (AFHK) in applying for the Tennessee Department of Health's "Healthy Kids' Rural School Health Systems of Care" initiative. If awarded, this partnership would provide approximately \$250,000 over a five year period to strengthen school health infrastructure, family engagement community partnerships, and connections to health and support services for students and families.

Approve the Cocke County School System to partner with Action for Healthy Kids' (AFHK) in applying for the Tennessee Department of Health's Healthy Active Rural Tennessee (HART) grant. If awarded, this grant would be a two-year opportunity focused on enhancing school environments to support physical activity and active living. Approximately \$30,000 - \$60,000 may be available for the district to support local school-based physical activity enhancements.

Approve the purchase of school furniture for various schools from VIRCO for \$44,388.60. Purchase is off of the state TIPS contract. Funds will come from general purpose.

Approve the bid of \$35,988 from Contract Paper Group, Inc. for copy paper in the district (1200 cases). Bid on file.

Approve the purchase of Canvas as an LMS platform for staff and 6-12 students at a cost of \$7,626. Funds to come from General Purpose.

Approve the purchase of Mastery Connect as the common formative assessment platform for students at a cost of \$59,197.73. Funds to come from General Purpose.

Approve the purchase of Frontline Education Time & Attendance Software for all employees and substitutes at a cost of \$24,092.80. Funds will come from General Purpose.
